MATH 102: Mathematical Concepts II (3) (MATH 121=) Offered prior to Fall 2013 at BCCC
(Must have been taken under this title.)

MATH 117: Finite Mathematics for Business (3) (Core: Quantification)

As of Fall 2013 course re-evaluation at Holy Family University.

MATH 120: College Algebra (4) (Core: Quantification)

MATH 122: Trigonometry/Analytic Geometry (3) (MATH 150=)

MATH 125: Pre-calculus Mathematics (4) (MATH 150=)

MATH 140: Calculus I (4) (MATH 211=)

*The BCCC student may also select MATH 101: Mathematical Concepts I (3) (MATH 122=) or MATH 115: Statistics (3) (MATH 130=) to fulfill the Math requirement at Bucks County Community College; however, **neither** of these courses will fulfill the Core: Mathematics requirement at Holy Family University and another Math course which will fulfill the Core requirement will be required at Holy Family University.*

NOTE: As a History major the student will need to replace the core history courses required, since these courses are required in the major and therefore cannot be used to fulfill a core requirement. The following meets that specification:

LITR 254 (ENGL 201) fulfills required Core replacement course for National/Global Perspective #3 requirement for HISTORY majors.

LITR 255 (ENGL 202) fulfills required Core replacement course for National/Global Perspective #4 requirement for HISTORY majors.

@ The student may select either GEOG 110 (GEOG 205) or POLI 130 (POLS 103). The course not completed at BCCC will be taken at Holy Family University.

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Additional information regarding HISTORY concentration:

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for commencement honors

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester; however, admission is possible in both the Fall and Spring semesters in this program of study since course offerings permit sequence adjustment.
